GOSPEL

+ Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke. Lk 16, 19-31.

Jesus said to his disciples: "There was a rich man who dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously each day. And lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Dogs even used to come and lick his sores. When the poor man died, he was carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried, and from the netherworld, where he was in torment, he raised his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side. And he cried out, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me. Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am suffering torment in these flames'. Abraham replied, 'My child, remember that you received what was good

during your lifetime while Lazarus likewise received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented. Moreover, between us and you a great chasm is established to prevent anyone from crossing who might wish to go from our side to yours or from your side to ours.'

He said, 'Then I beg you, father, send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, so that he may warn them lest they too come to this place of torment. But Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the prophets. Let them listen to them'. He said, 'Oh no, father Abraham, but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent'. Then Abraham said, 'If they will not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead'.

- L. Father Eusebe-Henri Menard used to say that *to be a committed layperson was to live a true spirituality close to the reality of each day*. Lord, may all baptized christians discover each day the winding contours of human history. Give

them the grace to be meaningful witnesses, capable of questioning the world and of challenging it in order to make it brimming over with justice, love and peace. (A.)

- L. Father Eusebe-Henri Menard used to say that to be a committed layperson was to be able to question, listen and reflect. Lord, give all baptized christians to be open to the signs of the times, to be looking forward with enthusiasm to each new day. That they may be able to discern the meaning of God's actions, callings, signs of hope and inspirations of the Holy Spirit, here and now, for themselves and for the whole world. (A.)
- L. Father Eusebe-Henri Menard used to say that *to be a committed layperson was to believe in the power of prayer.* Lord, give all baptized christians the grace to rediscover the real meaning of christian prayer and to make it their own each day: a prayer in Christ, with Christ through the Holy Spirit. (A.)
- P. Lord, give your Church shepherds and committed laypersons according to the heart of your Son and fill us with love and zeal, we ask this through Christ, Our Lord.

September 1946 Opening of the Apostolic School : Saint-

Pascal-Baylon

12 May 1951 Cardinal P.-E. Leger favors the founda-

tion project of a Society of Common Life

without public vows.

15 August 1951 The Archbishop of Montreal approves the

foundation project of the Society of the Holy Apostles, society of common life without public vows, dedicated to the formation of vocations to the priesthood of young men and adults, to the direction of

Retreat Houses and poor parishes.

1952 Opening of the Seminary of the Holy

Apostles at Côte-Sainte-Catherine

(Diocese of Saint-Jean-Longuueuil)

25 March 1956 Decree of erection by Cardinal P.-E.

Leger of the Society of the Holy Apostles

as a pious union.

10 July 1957 Opening in Cromwell, Ct, USA (Diocese

of Norwich) of the Holy Apostles

Seminary.

1960 Opening of Saint-Jean-Vianney College at

Rivière-des-Prairie, Montreal.

1960 The Missionaries of the Holy Apostles

begin their apostolic work in the Amazon

(Peru).

1961 Acquisition of the estate under the name

of Marie-Reine-des-Coeurs, Chertsey

(Diocese of Joliette), Canada

1962 Foundation of the Scolasticat in

Washington, DC, USA

15 August 1962 Approval of the Society of the

Missionaries of the Holy Apostles as a pious union, in Indiana (Peru) by Msgr Damase Laberge, O.F.M., Bishop of the Apostolic Vicariat of Saint Joseph of the

Amazon (Peru).

15 August 1965 Decree of erection of the Society of the

Holy Apostles promulgated by Cardinal

P.E. Leger.

11 November 1965 to

10 January 1966 Visit of Fr. Remi Couture to Tchad and

Cameroon regarding a foundation in

Africa.

Opening of the Seminary of the Holy

Apostles in Nsimalen (Yaounde)

12 December 1966 Opening of the Seminario de los Santos

Apostoles in Bogota (Colombia)

12 January 1967 Creation of the Parish Conceiçio de Nova

Aparecida in Campinas (Brazil)

17 December 1967

The moving of the Seminary of the Holy Apostles from Nsimalen to Otele.

28 March 1969

Taking over the Minor Seminary of Saint Thérèse of Mvolye (Yaounde)

1 November 1971

Recognition of the Society of the Missionaries of the Holy Apostles as a Society of common life without public vows of diocesan right, by a decree from the Bishop of the Apostolic Vicariat of Saint Joseph of the Amazon (Peru), Msgr Laurent Guibord, O.F.M. The Society is under the governance of the Congregation for the Evangelization of the People (Propaganda Fide).

7 March 1972

Demise of Mr. Hector Durand, co-founder of the Work of the Holy Apostles

May 1985

Opening in Assisi (Italy) of a vocational Centre in collaboration with the French Poor Clares.

23 February 1986

Acceptance by the Society to take charge of Saint-Paul's Minor Seminary in Bangui, Central African Republic.

26 March 1987

Demise of Fr. Eusebe-Henri Menard, Founder of the Work of the Holy Apostles. He is buried at the lot of the Society in the cemetery of the Parish of Saint-Josephde-Rivière-des-Prairies. **Juin 1987**

Beginning of a procedure towards the unification of the two Societies founded by Fr. Eusebe Menard.

July-August 1995

From 30 July to 18 August, a General Assembly is held in preparation of the unification of the two Societies. 21 members of each of both Societies take part in the deliberations.

15 August 1995

Foundation of the Society of the Missionaries of the Holy Apostles. The decree of foundation is read by Cardinal Jean-Claude Turcotte.

20 October 1997

Eucharistic celebration in the Cathedral Marie-Reine-du-Monde (Montreal), presided by Msgr. Laurent Guilbord, ofm, Apostolic Vicar of Saint-Joseph-of-the-Amazon, Peru, and concelebrated by fifty priests in the presence of more than 750 persons on the occasion of the closure of the jubilee year (50) of the Foundation of the Work of the Holy Apostles.

29 Juin 2000

Recognition of the Society of the Missionaries of the Holy Apostles as a clerical Society of Apostolic Life of Pontifical Right.
